## VENUE

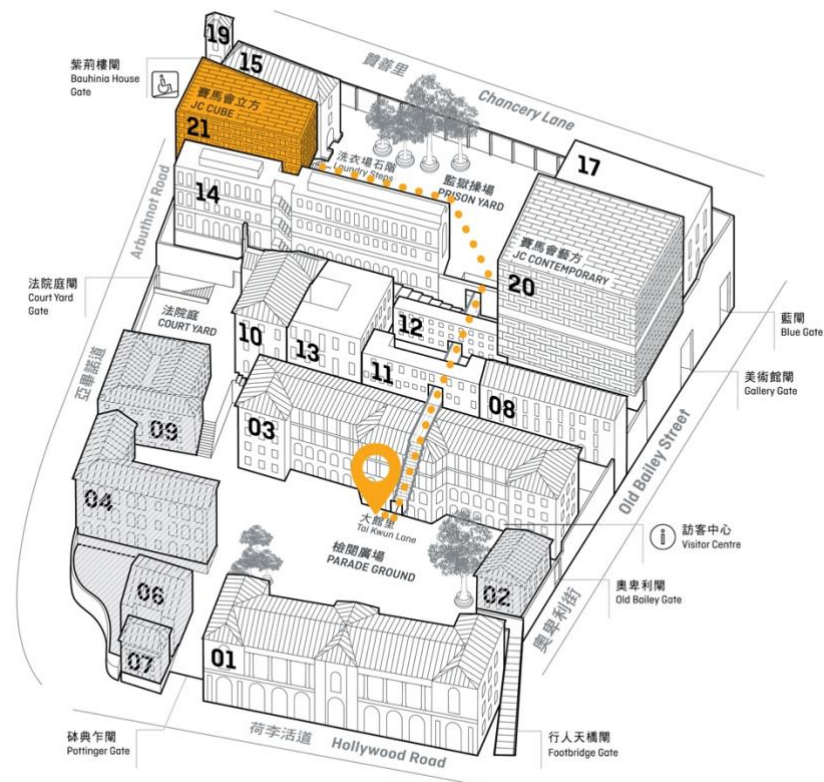
Our 2-day conference (13-14 May) will be held in Tai Kwun, Central, Hong Kong Island (please see compound map to the right, or this website, for more information: [https://www.taikwun.hk/en/visit/map\\_directory](https://www.taikwun.hk/en/visit/map_directory)).

The main conference venue is **JC Cube** (building 21) for registration and talks. Posters, lunches & coffee breaks will be held in **Lower E Hall** (under building 15) just next to JC Cube.

The closest road-side gate to the compound is **Bauhinia House Gate** (building 19) in the top right-hand corner of the compound, off Arbutnot Road.

The easiest way from the MTR is to take the escalators up from **Hong Kong/Central station** directly into Tai Kwun Parade Ground near the lower end of the compound and walk up through via the staircase.
